EXPANSIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS



Intermodal Expansion

Expansion plans include a new on-dock intermodal facility that will introduce 5,000 more feet of working track at the Port of Wilmington. When complete, the intermodal service will be expanded to a capacity of more than 50,000 rail movements annually. Combined with the Port of Wilmington's high vessel productivity and no on-port dwell, the rail services are unmatched for reliable intermodal connections to North Carolina and beyond.

Harbor Deepening

Demand for access to the Wilmington Harbor is growing as North Carolina strengthens its position as a freight gateway. In order to keep pace with demand and open new opportunities, NC Ports is working with its federal partners on necessary navigational harbor enhancements that will enable the Port of Wilmington to better accommodate deep-draft container vessels.



Expansion of the Container Yard

The container yard expansion will double the Port of Wilmington's annual throughput capacity to more than one million TEUs. This includes a new refrigerated container yard that currently offers more than 1,500 reefer plugs, with the ability to increase that number as we expand the port's container terminal.

New Container Gate Complex and Terminal and Gate Operating System

The new container gate complex at the Port of Wilmington enables NC Ports to meet the demand of increased container volume while maintaining record turn times. Improvements include increasing truck traffic lanes to 13, in addition to implementing new terminal and gate operating systems that make the port safer and more efficient.
